

Various administrative and leadership roles in Cotswold Edge District Explorer Scout Units

Our Explorer Scouts Units provide scouting opportunities for 14 – 17 year olds (up to their 18th birthday) and the Young Leader Unit provided training and support for those who volunteer as Young Leaders in the Scout Groups in the district.

We have 8 Explorer Scout Units spread across the district on different evenings of the week and the Young Leader Unit also moves its venue around the district. Several of our Units require additional adult support descriptions of roles are:

Unit Assistant (UA): This role could be Administrative such as keeping the Units membership records, Duke of Edinburgh Award records administration, maintaining website or facebook information, or you could take on a specific role such as a specific skill or activity, or be Unit Treasurer or a Unit helper without taking on the Unit leadership role. The actual role would be agreed between you and the Unit's Explorer Scout Leader (ESL) to whom you would be responsible. (Unit Treasurer would also be accountable to the District Treasurer).
